

# IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

## DEWALT®, Stanley®, and Craftsman® Fiberglass Sledgehammers

Stanley Black & Decker has identified the hazard that the head of the sledgehammers can loosen prematurely on its first or early use and detach unexpectedly, posing an impact injury hazard to the user.
