WARNINGS

1. Always wear safety glasses when using these tools.

2. Perform this operation in a well ventilated area.

3. Always refer to the appropriate SDS (Safety Data Sheet) for comprehensive information about a mixture for proper use and safe handling in the workplace.

4. Always refer to your local, State, Federal and/or National laws for proper disposal of the empty cylinder.

HANDLING DIRECTIONS

Read the SDS (Safety Data Sheet) if you are not sure about the properties of the gas mixture.

- 1. Cylinders must be EMPTY. Full cylinders must be safely relieved of pressure by use of a regulator.
- 2. Flammable gas mixtures must be emptied away from all possible sources of ignition.
- 3. Hold cylinder with valve away from face. Use caution when working with calibration cylinders. If you are unfamiliar with their use, contact someone who is knowledgeable.
- 4. Vent contents outdoors or under a properly rated lab hood.
- 5. Always wear safety glasses and proceed slowly when working with the cylinders.
- 6. Emptied cylinder may now be disposed of or recycled in accordance with local, State, Federal and/or National laws.
